

HOLLYWOOD NORTH BEACH UTILITIES UNDERGROUND CONVERSION

DESCRIPTION

The City of Hollywood is working with the Whiting-Turner Contracting Company, and Keith and Associates to perform preliminary vacuum excavation soft-digs to facilitate the upcoming North Beach Utilities Underground Conversion Project. Work will be from Balboa Street to Franklin Street (between A1A and Surf Road), and Douglas Street to Freedom Street (between A1A and Surf Road).

Vacuum excavation soft-digs will be performed to identify buried existing utilities. This is the least invasive and the most efficient method for exploratory work. Excavations and restoration at each location will be no more than 1-2 hours. Each excavation will typically be a 12"x12" along the asphalt roadway or sidewalk. Entrances to homes and businesses may be temporarily blocked during these periods.

TIMING

Construction will begin on 4/8/2024 and is expected to be completed by 5/20/2024. Work will generally take place Monday through Friday from 8am to 5pm. There will be no overnight work during this period.

The schedule is subject to change based on inclement weather and unforeseen conditions.



TRAFFIC AND PARKING IMPACTS

- As Keith & Associates works on each street progressing North to South, their equipment will be parked in front of certain residences for up to 1-2 hours. If vehicles need to be utilized during this time, we ask that they be temporarily relocated.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times
- Please follow the posted signs and drive with caution, as workers will be present.
